
WITH A SERVICE OF COMMUNION WE WILL MARK THE FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT next Sunday, February 14. Please prepare as you best know how for this celebration of God's communion with us, in Christ, and of our communion with God and each other, through Christ, as symbolized in the bread and the cup, and their sharing.

LENT BEGINS ON WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 10, the 40-day season of preparation for Easter. For worship we will follow our denominational resource, *Living Ink*, which focuses on the spiritual virtue of surrender, letting God, the Divine Author, write his story in our lives. Other Lent offerings include:

- An Ash Wednesday service, from 12:15 to 1PM on February 10
- Wednesday services of prayer during Lent, from 12:15 to 1PM
- A service of communion on February 14, the first Sunday of Lent
- A Maundy Thursday evening service on March 24

For many years at Zion, we have started Bible School on the last Sunday of July.
