- 4 adult-size toothbrushes
- 4 new bath towels (medium weight, dark or bright colors)
- 2 wide-tooth combs (6–8 in)
- 1 fingernail clipper (good quality)
- 1 box adhesive bandages (minimum 40 count, assorted)

• 1 package sanitary pads (18–24 count *thin* maxi) *If you cannot find the laundry soap, we will purchase this separately. Don't have time to shop? Checks can be made out to Zion Mennonite Church with "MCC Relief Kits" in the subject line. We'll use the money for soap and/or shipping costs.
