WE WILL BE COLLECTING RELIEF KITS FOR REFUGEES throughout the Advent season to commission on Epiphany Sunday. Relief kits provide valuable supplies to families whose lives have been disrupted by war or disaster.

Contents (NEW items only, in original packaging)

- 4 large bars bath soap
- 1 plastic bottle shampoo (13–24 oz; place in resealable plastic bag)
- 4 large bars laundry soap (Some stores carry Fels Naptha®, Sunlight® or Zote® brands)
- 4 adult-size toothbrushes
- 4 new bath towels (medium weight, dark or bright colors)
- 2 wide-tooth combs (6-8 in)
- 1 fingernail clipper (good quality)
- 1 box adhesive bandages (minimum 40 count, assorted)
- 1 package sanitary pads (18–24 count thin maxi)

If you prefer to donate money, it can be used to purchase the laundry soap bars, which are sometimes hard to find. Or it will be sent to MCC to use for shipping costs. Checks can be made to Zion Mennonite Church with "relief kits" designated in the memo line. Donated items may be left in the foyer.
