He will teach, lead and generate discussion on Jesus' way of interpreting the Bible in The Gospel According to Matthew, with one session on Friday night (April 20) and three on Saturday (April 21). He will provide a concert for all ages (children and the child in all of us) on Saturday evening. Bryan will also speak to combined youth and adult classes on Sunday, April 22 and bring the message during worship. Attendees are invited to join us from the area and the conference.
