"The fast that I choose... to set free the oppressed...to share your bread with the hungry..." (Isaiah 58) is God's call during the Lenten season. One way to do so is through fundraisers for Bridging Cultures Canby (March 16), Vida Feliz Senior Center in Bolivia (March 31), and throughout this season for the food bank services of The Canby Center and Jubilee Food Pantry.

To remember the hunger at the source of all hungers (for God), we present Psalm 63:1-8 (ESV) for memorization and recital during our worship services. You may keep the copy below for your reference:

Psalm 63:1-8

- O God, you are my God; earnestly I seek you; my soul thirsts for you; my flesh faints for you, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water.
- ² So I have looked upon you in the sanctuary, beholding your power and glory.
- ³ Because your steadfast love is better than life, my lips will praise you.
- *So I will bless you as long as I live; in your name I will lift up my hands.
- ⁵ My soul will be satisfied as with fat and rich food, and my mouth will praise you with joyful lips,
- ⁶ when I remember you upon my bed, and meditate on you in the watches of the night;
 ⁷ for you have been my help,
- and in the shadow of your wings I will sing for joy. ⁸ My soul clings to you; your right hand upholds me.

Nurture your children's faith at home this Lent and Easter. Find a free, downloadable Lent At Home guide at

mennoniteusa.org/lent2019. It includes Bible readings, short litanies, songs, hands-on activities and questions to ponder from March 5 through Easter Sunday on April 21. **Got a testimony? A witness on your heart** of what God has done for you? Or of what you need and seek from God? During each Sunday service of Lent this year, we will ask, "Who will call upon the Lord today?" followed by one person's sharing of a short testimony in keeping with the theme of that Sunday. Those themes will include: enduring/overcoming trial and temptation; awakening to God and God's call; personal renewal and transformation; reconciliation and restoration of relationships; of dashed and restored hopes, or more.
