Please look for an email coming soon with instructions for signing up for a group session. Sessions will begin the week of August 24.

Information about Group Sessions: These will be in-person group meetings of 8 people for 90 minutes. Each person would be given uninterrupted time to share from their perspective. I would invite them to share about the following 10 categories of congregational life (these areas surfaced in gathering information thus far):

- Mission and purpose
- Worship and spirituality
- Christian education and faith formation
- Caring for each other
- Caring from the Pastors and staff
- Caring for the Pastors and staff
- Caring conflict transformation
- · Communication and decision making
- Structures and leadership
- Pastor search process

People could also share about anything else they want to share regarding the congregation. During these small group sessions, I will be documenting the interests that each person is sharing. These interests will be saved and will be used later in the interim time when we get to working on problem-solving.
