However in light of the rising number of daily cases and hospitalizations due to Covid 19 infections, we cannot promote in person services as safe. Though diligent mask wearing and physically distancing decrease the risk of spreading the virus, there still remains a possibility of infecting each other which could result in serious illness and even death.

As travel from other communities increases over the holidays, we anticipate even more spread of infection. For this reason, we will continue to hold remote only services only through the end of the year and into January.

The Leadership Team will continue to assess and wrestle with how to meet together again in the new year. Please pray for us as we work to do church and support community over the next months. **Office Hours:** All church facilities remain closed.
