

Do you know what a "grueling" journey means? I picture a lot of grumbling happening when something is grueling. Mary and Joseph are starting a long, hard journey in this story. When we think of the trip before Jesus's birth, we picture Mary riding on a donkey. Did you know that the Bible doesn't tell us HOW they travelled? If Mary did get to ride a donkey, she was probably happy to not be walking, because it was a long trip, and Mary was very pregnant! If you have ever seen a pregnant lady walking, you know it doesn't look very easy, but probably just a little worse than riding on a stubborn, uncomfortable donkey! Whether she was walking or riding a donkey, the Bible doesn't mention that Mary complains or even grumbles! Do you remember last week's story when Mary sings: "My soul gives glory to the Lord. My spirit delights in God my Savior. He has taken note of me even though I am not considered important"? 
