MDS Update:

In Marion/Linn Counties, the Santiam Canyon Long Term Recovery Group (LTRG) is working with Christian Aid Ministries to build 10 homes this year. The Clackamas County LTRG is working with local businesses and contractors to donate time and materials to build four houses this year. At this time both counties and the state have asked MDS to assist in an advisory capacity. House plans have been revised and reviewed by Clackamas Co. and upon approval will be used for the first home build in Estacada. Other counties are beginning to get to the stage of home restoration. Oregon may be able to support one project with some binational help. At this time, we are waiting for the Lord's leading to select the most appropriate response for the MDS Oregon Unit.
