Mennonite Disaster Services Update...

John Colvin and several volunteers from the Albany Corvallis area will be working on the Estacada house (5 miles outside of Estacada) sponsored by the Clackamas County Long Term Recovery Group, November 17-20, 2021. Local contractors have been donating their time and skills to get the home dried in with most of the materials also donated. The house is framed up, sheeted and roofed with the installation of windows and doors. Rough plumbing and electrical have been done. John and his volunteers will be installing cabinets, laminate flooring, interior doors and closet doors, trim work around windows, doors and baseboard, and porch railing. They ask for your thoughts and prayers for travel safety and safety on the job while they work on this project. Three more homes are in various stages of the permitting process near Molalla, OR. More volunteer help may be needed as those projects get off the ground. Please be thinking how you might be able to assist if the call for volunteers goes out.
