Our MDS tool trailer made its maiden voyage to Estacada on November 16 to be in place for John Colvin and 5 volunteers (from the Albany & Corvallis areas) who did substantial work for the home owners, Robin and Gary, from November 17-20, including installing cabinets, laminate flooring, interior and closet doors, and trim work. MDS Oregon also built a pump house for the owners. The power to the house has been activated. The new owners are installing appliances and getting the home ready for occupancy very soon. Robin and Gary live on 2 acres where they had a home, barn and shop. When the wildfires came in 2020, they had 10 minutes to gather things and flee to safety. When they returned, everything was gone. They are very grateful for all the help that they have received. MDS Oregon finished their commitment on this project on December 1.

- 4 new bath towels (medium weight, dark or bright colors)
- 2 wide-tooth combs (6–8 in)
- 1 fingernail clipper (good quality)
- 1 box adhesive bandages (minimum 40 count, assorted)
- Sanitary Pads—*Thin* 1 or 2 packages, minimum 28 pads total) If possible, please purchase items for complete kits
