Budget Report: Offering 1/2/22: \$2,550

MCC U.S. is hosting a Young Adult Peacebuilders Training in Colorado this Spring! Young adults ages 18-30 are invited to participate in a rich, week-long experience that will provide an opportunity to build new relationships, visit organizations doing powerful work in and around Colorado Springs, and apply Anabaptist, Biblical foundations of peace, and justice to real-world issues. Rocky Mountain Mennonite Camp will serve as a home base for participants, offering a beautiful and relaxing space to rest, study, and have fun together as a group.

This Peacebuilders Training will touch on themes of racial equity, immigration, mass incarceration, gun violence, and conflict transformation. Peacebuilders Training will provide young adults with tools to implement their own dreams of peace and justice in their local communities.
