At the congregational budget meeting last Sunday, action was taken for these items:

- The 2021 Budget Report and 2022 Budget were approved.
   Included in the Budget are two part-time positions:
  - Youth Director. There is a need for ongoing conversation about Zion's broader vision for this position
  - Facilities Manager. 10 hours/week to help us stay on top of our short and long term facility needs
- The Constitution was approved. ZLT will take a closer look at the article about dissolution and present a recommendation at the spring congregational meeting on May 1.

ZLT is monitoring OHA's recommendations about wearing masks indoors and when that changes, masks will be optional at Zion as well.
