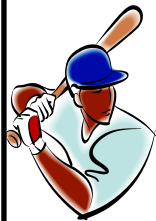

John Colvin, our Oregon Mennonite Disaster Service Chair person, is considering building a house for a family in the Lyons area who lost their home in the 2020 fires. Earlier John was in contact with the Christian Aid Ministries (CAM) group about doing the framing on the house. No commitment to build the Lyon house has been made to date. John is gathering information on costs to build and wants to get some idea how many local people could help with the project.
