Mennonite Disaster Service:

John Colvin, Oregon Unit Chairperson is asking for volunteers to help finish the third house in the Eagle Creek fire area. In the first few weeks of August, two groups of volunteers for 3 work days (Wednesday—Friday) are needed to accomplish these tasks: install laminate flooring, interior doors, windows and baseboards, and trim work. He is asking for donations to cover the cost and installation of cabinets. Persons of all skill levels are needed. If you have never installed laminate flooring or installed trim and you would like to learn new skills, you would work with someone who has done it before. MDS Oregon Unit will reimburse volunteers for food, lodging and travel. If you are able to volunteer but not able to work all 3 days on each project, let us know and we will see how your schedule might fit within the needs of MDS.
