


Year End Giving Update:

Wow, what a generous year of giving we have had here at Zion. Thank you!

Our preliminary numbers for 2025 are:

- ◊ Budget Offerings: \$340,603
- ◊ Actual Expenses: \$329,870
- ◊ New Roof Fund: \$55,890
- ◊ Bolivia Flood Relief: \$9,430
- ◊ MCC Trim the Tree Total : \$4,448.38, which equals 84 Chickens, 53 Water Projects, 54 Ducks, 20 Girls to School, and \$307.38 to the Hope Fund.



Our 2026 Budget Meeting is scheduled for February 1st. At that time, we will be presenting the final numbers for 2025 and reviewing our upcoming 2026 fiscal year.

DONATIONS NEEDED FOR MCC INFANT KITS

Zion Mennonite Women are seeking help to obtain the items needed for Mennonite Central Committee's Infant Kits. These kits are given to families who have been displaced by conflict or disaster, and to those who lack access to the supplies needed to care for an infant. Each kit consists of:

- ◆ 3 gowns/sleepers (flannel or similar warm, soft material)
- ◆ 3 undershirts/onesies (short or long sleeves)
- ◆ 4 large, heavy duty safety pins
- ◆ 1 large bar mild soap (in wrapper)
- ◆ 1 pair of socks
- ◆ 1 cap

Donations must be new and in sizes 6-12 months, and can be left in the pack-and-play in the church foyer. These items will then be collected into receiving blankets that are being sewn by members of ZMW. For questions, contact Jenna Oyer.
