DONATIONS NEEDED FOR MCC INFANT KITS

Zion Mennonite Women are seeking help to obtain the items needed for Mennonite Central Committee's Infant Kits. These kits are given to families who have been displaced by conflict or disaster, and to those who lack access to the supplies needed to care for an infant. Each kit consists of:

- ♦ 3 gowns/sleepers (flannel or similar warm, soft material)
- ♦ 3 undershirts/onesies (short or long sleeves)
- ♦ 4 large, heavy duty safety pins
- ♦ 1 large bar mild soap (in wrapper)
- ♦ 1 pair of socks
- ♦ 1 cap

Donations must be new and in sizes 6-12 months, and can be left in the pack-and-play in the church foyer. These items will then be collected into receiving blankets that are being sewn by members of ZMW. For questions, contact Jenna Oyer.

TERRACYCLE DROP-OFF INFORMATION

WHAT: Terracycle is an organization that partners with hundreds of brands to recycle items via mail that are otherwise not recyclable. In addition, money can be earned for charitable organizations, currently Drift Creek Camp.

WHERE & HOW: A collection container in the Fellowship Hall is waiting for your "donations" of the following: used toothbrushes, empty toothpaste tubes and floss containers, disposable razors and their packaging, and sauce packets (Taco Bell, ketchup, etc.) Beauty products, deodorant containers, plastic food containers, and socks are no longer accepted. A complete printed list is available at the collection container.
