This is approximately \$25,000 less than what was received at this same time last year, with expenses matching last year's amount of approximately \$160,000.

BOLIVIA FLOOD RELIEF UPDATE

After a devastating flood tore through the community of Espejos, Bolivia last December, Wendell and Karen Amstutz have been busy facilitating relief efforts. Out of the almost \$10,000 that was sent to Bolivia from Zion, \$3,000 has been spent on: cellphones for community leaders, repair materials for seven community water systems, logistics support for well cleaning, and installing a road culvert.

This last week, a team from a regenerative agriculture nonprofit came to assess the flooded farmland and to present next steps. Because soil recovery is not a part of any government program in Bolivia, it is expected that donated funds from Zion, MCC and others will be put towards this effort. There are also plans to assist those who have lost their homes, but do not qualify for the government housing program. Please continue to pray for the people of Espejos and the efforts of Wendell and Karen. We look forward to hearing more from Karen when she visits in August.
