7/27/26 Offering: \$9,974.30

Thank you for your generous support that keeps Zion serving our community. Zion's budget offering through July was \$170,285.18, which is 48% of our 2026 budgeted total of \$351,700. This is approximately \$29,000 less than what was received at this same time last year, while expenses for the year are at approximately \$201,640.
